
## One Year Later: No End In Sight For Supply Chain Crisis

After one year of surveying companies in the medical supply chain, HIDA has found only slight reductions in the length of shipping delays and the volume of delayed medical containers. These persistent delays remain far above pre-COVID levels.

## Stakeholders Predict Persistent Delays For 2023


Over 90% of survey respondents reported the situation has stayed the same or worsened over the last three months.
